

Those players who regularly compete or want to compete in table hockey tournaments, who have or seek international / worldwide ranking, who seek a sanctioned event, and who want to test their skills against other players from around the world. The Professional Division of Table Hockey Tournaments is limited to 64 players for each of the four tournaments: Stiga, SoHo Pro, SoHo 5380, and SuperChexx; and will award prize money to playoff winners.




Tickets - Bottom of the Pro TH Tournament Registration page

Registering a Family of Four

Scenario: A family of four (4), Dad wants him and his son and daughter to play in the same, Pro, tournament. Because Dad is registering to play, now one of his children can play for FREE. His wife wants to watch them play. Also, all of them want to attend Friday Night's Charity Event.

So, they select:

4 Charity Event Tickets

1 Pro Player, age 21+

1 Pro Player, age 10-20

*** Disregard if you see, "without parent" or "registering on their own."**

STEPS: To register one child for FREE, then select only "1" Pro Player Adult 21+ ticket and click "Add to Cart." Select as many of the tickets in the other categories as you need, for example, Pro Player ages 10-20, Charity, or General Admission.

When you get to the page where you write in your information (Register), you can also add the child's information whom you are registering for free.

Cart - Quantities Too Many?

Scenario: Family of Four

Let's say, Dad went to register previously but did not pay. The Cart kept in memory his past selections.

Simply reduce the "Quantity" by selecting how many tickets you need per Product.

Then select, "Update Cart." Once you are confident you have the correct number of tickets for each Product (category), then click "Proceed to Checkout."

Updated Cart & Proceeding to Checkout

Scenario: Family of Four

On this page you see, Dad, has updated his cart.

He wants:

- 1 Pro Player age 21+ with Child Free - for his daughter
- 4 Charity tickets - for his family of four
- 1 Pro Player age 10-20 - for his son
- 1 General Admission - for his wife

He is confident his quantities are correct, so he clicks "Proceed to Checkout."

Are the Quantities Correct?

If not...

Scenario: Family of Four

On the previous page you see, Dad, checked that all quantities were correct.

But, on the next page he finds the numbers are wrong. (See quantities circled in red).

Remember he wants only:

- 1 Pro Player age 21+ with Child Free - for his daughter
- 4 Charity tickets - for his family of four
- 1 Pro Player age 10-20 - for his son
- 1 General Admission - for his wife

To fix this click, ["Back to Cart"](#)

Go two slides back to slide #7, "Cart - Quantities Too Many?" Once there set the quantities you need, click "Update Cart," and this will fix the problem.

Scenario: Family of Four.
